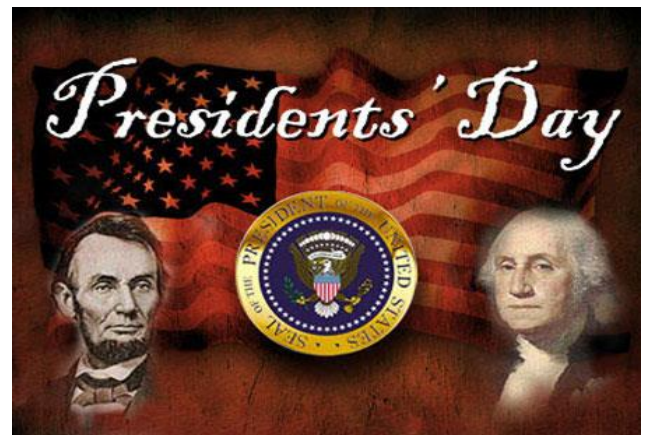
Dear Members of the Deacons:

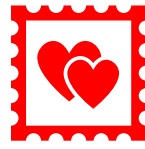
