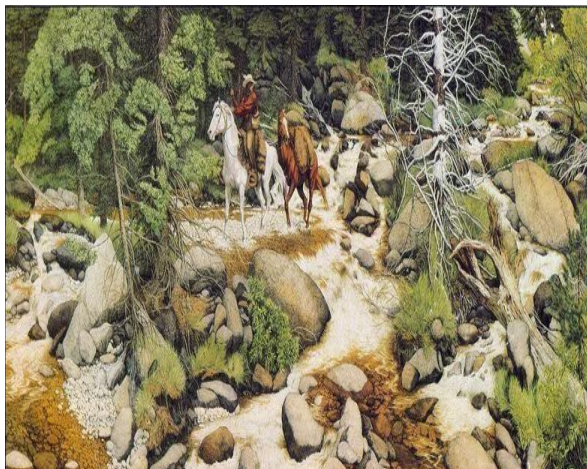

Of course, there are easier optical illusions out there that we deal with every day.

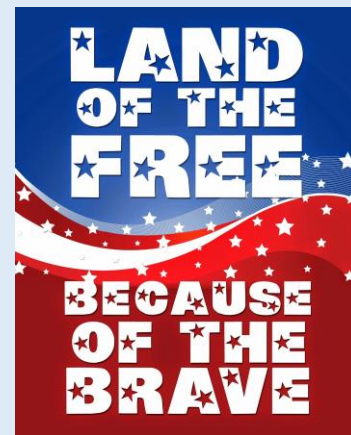
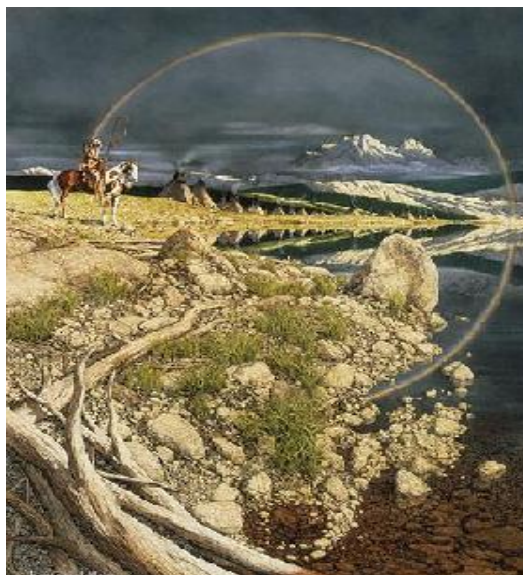
Things like, I am in charge, I have made it on my own, I can totally handle my life with no help from friends or family. I am an island.

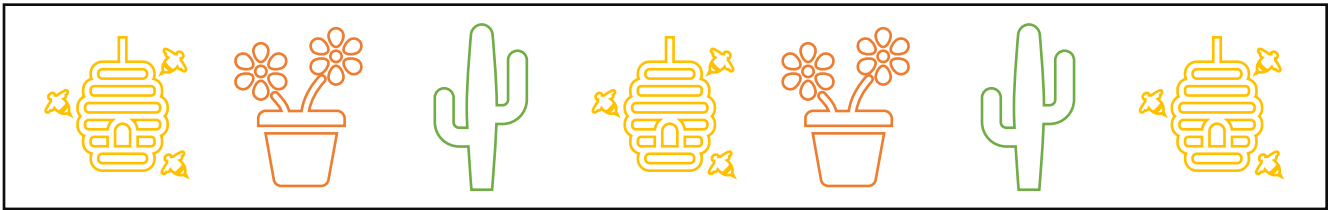
